

2026 NUTCRACKER STUDENT MATINEE TICKET AGREEMENT

AS THE PERSON COMPLETING THIS TICKET FORM, I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM REPRESENTING MY SCHOOL AND AGREEING TO THE SPECIFIED RESPONSIBILITIES AND POLICIES OUTLINED BELOW. FAILURE TO MEET THE RESPONSIBILITIES MAY RESULT IN THE REVOCATION OF TICKETS AND THE ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FUTURE.

I. THE NUTCRACKER STUDENT MATINEE

- **Date:** Wednesday, December 9, 2026
- **Location:** The Warner Theatre
- **Time:** 11:00 a.m. –1:30 p.m.

II. GROUP LEADER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- The group leader will be the main point of contact for the program and must respond to communication leading up to the matinee.
- Schedule the group's transportation to the Warner Theatre to arrive no later than 10:30 a.m., and transportation back to the school immediately following the student matinee.
- The group leader must attend the student matinee with the students and be reachable by cell phone on the morning of the event.
- No later than 1 month prior to the student matinee the group leader must:
 1. Notify TWB if any member of your group has a disability and requires special assistance or accommodation.
 2. Provide modes of transportation to and from the theatre for the group.
- Ensure there is an adequate number of chaperones for the number of students attending the student matinee. 1 chaperone per 10 students is required.
- Complete and submit any evaluation materials to The Washington Ballet.
- Acknowledge The Washington Ballet in any publicity or notices concerning the student matinee performance or partnership.

III. THE WASHINGTON BALLET STUDENT MATINEE POLICIES

- Groups are seated as they arrive at the theatre. This keeps groups flowing into the theatre in a safe and timely manner.
- Latecomers will be seated at the discretion of the House Manager, who will attempt to seat latecomers during the late seating break. It is possible that latecomers may be required to stand.
- Inclement Weather Policy –The Washington Ballet rarely cancels events due to inclement weather. If you are unable to attend the student matinee due to inclement weather, rescheduling will not be an option.
